February 22, 2017 Feast of the Chair of St. Peter

Dear Members of the Marian Movement of Priests,

We thank God for the Fatima Apparitions, as this year we celebrate their 100th anniversary (1917-2017). Our Blessed Mother came to help us in the battle between Her, the Woman Clothed with the Sun, and the Red Dragon. Fr. Gobbi always referred to the Red Dragon as Communist atheism which makes its advance to conquer the world beginning with the Bolshevik Revolution of 1917. That same year, Our Lady counter-attacked with the littleness of the three children to whom She appeared at Fatima. Her victories expand as we await Satan's final defeat. We have much to undergo, but Our Lady is with us, especially through her Marian Movement of Priests which originated from Heaven in 1972, same as Fatima in 1917. Let us follow Our Blessed Mother as She continues to lead us.

In reading the enclosed circular letter from our director general, Fr. Larroque, you will notice his concern as he addresses the often-perplexing issues that surround Pope Francis. Fr. Larroque approaches this matter in a prudent way. In her message given on March 25, 1979, she tell us: *"Within my Immaculate Heart I will build up your interior equilibrium, my beloved sons, because today you have need of being ever more prudent and well-balanced. This equilibrium will be a sign to all of what your heavenly Mother is doing in you and will assure the Church of finding in you faithful and wise sons...." (173q-r) I believe we must be cautious when making judgments about the Holy Father. There are numerous references in Our Lady's messages regarding unity with the Pope. Unless we have just cause to believe that he is teaching something other than the authentic teaching of the Church, we must pray and wait. In other words, don't jump the gun!*

On this Feast Day of the Chair of St. Peter, let us pray for Pope Francis and the Bishops, that they will remain faithful to the teachings of Christ and his Church.

And let us be at peace, knowing that we have the assurance from Our Blessed Mother that She will tell us whom we must follow in order to be faithful to the Vicar of her Son and to His Church. (cf. #1400, Dec. 8, 1977)

As members of Our Lady's Movement, we who are consecrated to her Immaculate Heart must have faith and trust! We belong to Her! We of all people should be relying on her direction and her inspirations. How many times has She told us not to look at all the negative things and evil that surround us! If Jesus had to die on the Cross, in a moment of complete abandonment, that was felt by Him, His Mother, and the Apostles and disciples, then don't you think we're going to share in these same sufferings? Our Lady says, "Let it be the sepulchre of your slavery, where the Church dies, the Church which is sick and divided, pervaded with the spirit of the world, darkened in its loyalty and holiness, assailed by the loss of faith and apostasy; and where the new Church is born, holy, faithful, enlightened, evangelical, poor and chaste, reflecting solely the light of its Christ upon the world." (471j, April 18, 1992 - Holy Saturday)

If Jesus had to die, then so too will it be for the Church, His Mystical Body, but It too will rise again like He did, more beautiful and resplendent than ever! We must persevere in our Faith - not leaving the Church, not leaving the cenacles, and remaining ever in Our Mother's Heart! In these turbulent times, we seek refuge in the Ark of Her Immaculate Heart, as She has instructed us many times. We pray and await her instructions as we live through this great unfolding of supernatural events. Let us have faith in Our Lady who is guiding us through these unimaginable and incomprehensible times, through the darkness that will bring us to the light of a new era – the New Heavens and the New Earth! "In the end my Immaculate Heart will triumph!"
